WHO CAN LEARN TO FLY

Anyone can learn to fly, the minimum age to fly solo is 16 yrs and to hold a Private Pilot 's Licence (PPL) you must be at least 17 yrs.

Private Pilot's Licence

Medical

A Class 2 medical certificate must be obtained before going solo. A good standard of general health is required and the wearing of glasses or contact lenses for correction of most sight problems will not prevent you passing a medical test or restrict your licence in any way.

Entry Selection Process

There are no minimum educational qualification requirements however a good standard of Maths and Physics is recommended. Private Pilot Licence examinations are set at the same level as secondary school exams. The Commercial Pilot Licence examinations being set at a tertiary level.

English Language

As English is the international language of aviation, it is a requirement for all pilot's to achieve a pass in the academic IELTS test of 5.0 or more across all bands.

The Civil Aviation Authority requires a minimum flight experience of 50 hours for a Private Pilot's Licence.
